Safety First: Parents please remind your children that there is NO RUNNING in the church for everyone's safety.

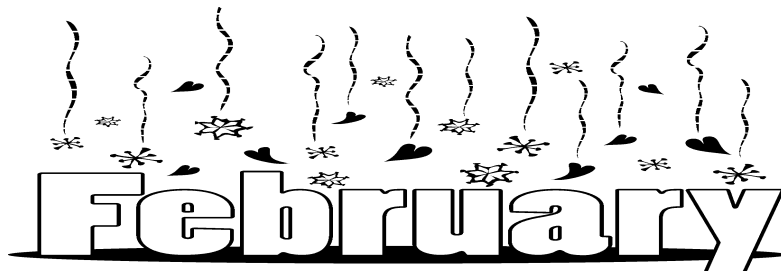
